

# Advanced Apprenticeship in Electrical Installation

The Advanced Apprenticeship in Electrotechnical Installation has been developed for candidates working towards a career in the Electrical Installation/Contracting Industry. The Apprenticeship scheme is a government initiative, and courses are heavily subsidised.

## Course Content

The Apprenticeship comprises the NVQ, Technical Certificate and Key Skills:

### NVQ - C&G 2356 (Level 3)

Apprentices build a portfolio of their electrical work, which is verified on-site by a WLT assessor. This element assesses practical competence. The AM2 qualification is also required as part of the NVQ.

### Technical Certificate - C&G 2330 (Level 2 & 3)

This covers all the underpinning knowledge (technology principles) and practical skills required to achieve the NVQ. It is divided into two parts:

#### Part 1 / Level 2 Units

- Working Effectively and Safely in an Electrotechnical Environment
- Principles of Electrotechnology
- Application of Health & Safety and Electrical Principles
- Installation

#### Part 2 / Level 3 Units

- Application of Health & Safety and Electrical Principles
- Installation: Inspection, Testing and Commissioning
- Installation: Fault Diagnosis and Rectification

## Key Skills

These are an integral part of the Apprenticeship programme. Three are required for Electrical Installation:

- Application of Number (Level 2)
- Communications (Level 2)
- I.C.T (Level 1)

## Training

Apprentices usually complete the course within 3 years. Day-release training takes place at WLT over 18 months for Part 1 and a further 15 months for Part 2. Apprentices spend the remainder of the week at their place of work, gaining experience and working towards their NVQ portfolio.

## Materials/Equipment

Core textbooks and training manuals are provided to students at the start of the course. Additional reference books may be recommended during the course. Tools and materials for use during practical sessions at WLT are provided. Students will need clothing and footwear suitable for workshop sessions.

## Assessment

Each unit of the Technical Certificate is assessed via an on-line external examination and/or assignment element. For Key Skills students undertake an on-line assessment for each skill and a project. The NVQ is assessed via portfolio verification by a WLT assessor.

## Pre-requisites

Applicants to the Apprenticeship should be aged between 16 and 24 years and be engaged within the industry. Limited funding may be available for apprentices aged over 25 years. As a guide to suitability, applicants should have a good standard of education with some practical aptitude and transferable skills. Formal knowledge and experience of electrical installation are not required.
